

The Palestinian Cause After October 7, 2023 and the Israeli War of Extermination on the Gaza Strip: In-Depth Studies and Analyses

Summary

.This book addresses the new environment created by the October 7 battle and the Israeli war of extermination on the Gaza Strip in 2023, discussing the main challenges and opportunities that emerged afterward. The book examines the strategic battle between Israel and the Palestinian resistance in dealing with these changes and their environments.

The second chapter reviews "Israel's Strategies in the War on Gaza" political, military and security during the war, which was formed in reality by committing war crimes and a war of genocide according to international reports and the International Court of Justice to end the Palestinian presence in the Gaza Strip, implement policies of gradual erosion of the Gaza Strip, impose geographical security arrangements in it, establish a "buffer zone" on the perimeter of the Gaza Strip, and produce a Palestinian civil administration in the Gaza Strip linked to the leadership of the Israeli occupation.

The third chapter discusses "the strategies of the Palestinian resistance in the October 7, 2023 operation and beyond", the most important of which are the strategy of strategic deception, the strategy of construction, the media strategy, and the political strategy.

Chapter Four reviews "the impact of the October 7 battle and the subsequent Israeli extermination war on the role of the international community regarding the Palestinian issue," including changes in the behavior and policies of various international organizations and bodies toward the Palestinian cause, starting with the Security Council and the General Assembly, and passing through the Human Rights Council, the International Court of Justice, the International Criminal Court, and others.

Finally, Chapter Five examines "the evolution of perceptions toward the Arab-Israeli conflict after October 7, 2023, and the Israeli extermination war, and the development of prevailing political and historical debates around the Arab-Israeli conflict and the Palestinian issue, such as the possibility and means of ending the Israeli occupation, the impact of the October 7 battle on the course of Arab-Israeli normalization and the temporary halt of normalization, the perceptual shifts on the strategies and tactics of the Palestinian-Israeli conflict and the main changes on both the Palestinian and Israeli sides, the shifts in Arab positions and strategies, and the new perceptions at the Palestinian, Arab, and international levels, such as the reproduction of international competition patterns in the region and the return of the Palestinian issue to global priorities.

In summary of the research and analyses presented in the book, the researchers emphasized the importance of studying and analyzing the qualitative transformation in the conflict and its repercussions at various levels. The studies also revealed the structural and ideological problems,

as well as the political approaches in the international community's dealings with the changes in the Arab-Israeli conflict, showing a biased and unjustified favoritism towards Israel as it carries out a campaign of genocide and war crimes against the Palestinian people. Meanwhile, the researchers noted that the international community, especially Western countries, focused only on the limited five-hour military operation carried out by the Palestinian resistance to thwart a new aggressive attack by the Israeli Gaza Division around the sector, without considering its backgrounds, defensive and preemptive motives in protecting the Palestinian people in Gaza, as well as its connection to the ongoing maritime, aerial, and land blockade, and the occupation's security and military control over the sector, suffocating it to death.
